The Disabled Living Centre has a display of equipment to assist independent living for people with physical disabilities, their carers and professional staff.

Centre

It is a demonstration and information resource centre concerned with the practical aspects of daily living. People can try out an up to date range of equipment.

Qualified staff are available to assist visitors to make an informed choice about equipment options.

The range of items on display at the centre includes; kitchen equipment, upright chairs, rise recliners, stairlifts, bath lifts, bath boards and seats, beds, dressing aids, powered wheelchairs, scooters, manual wheelchairs, four wheeled walkers with a seat, power packs and ramps.

Exhibition

Throughout the year there are special exhibitions to provide an opportunity to learn more about what is on the market relating to a specific subject. Usually there are associated seminars and an opportunity to see products from a variety of companies. These exhibitions are advertised locally and are targeted for the general public and health care professionals.

The centre is open from Monday to Friday; 8.30am – 4.30pm. To visit the centre it is necessary to make an appointment and complete a self – referral. The centre is fully accessible.
